2017 Season Outlook: The Bucks finished the fall season undefeated in conference play and 8 and 1 overall. They will feature a solid mix of upper classman leadership and youth, playing a difficult non-



conference schedule in the Spring to help them prepare for a run at a Conference, District and National Title. They will host Kent State and Slippery Rock and travel to former National Champions, Eastern Kentucky in April for a 4 game series in addition to the annual trip to the NCBA Spring Training Showcase in March.

The team lost several key players including 5 call-ups to DI but have reloaded with a very talented and deep incoming class. The pitching depth rivals it's 2015 team that won 30 games, as evident by it's fall season posting an outstanding 1.76 ERA with 60 K's and 1.22 WHIP in 56 innings with 7 players contributing. Newcomers Jackson Jennings, Eric Pfeifer, and Joe Juza will solidify the rotation along with the return of Kwang Oh and Matt Kascandi. Nick Bowden returns after posting an impressive 1.27 ERA last year before an injury derailed his season and looks to be in similar form having not allowed a run in 6 innings in the Fall. Brett Gibson will look to repeat his steller freshman season where he was 7 and 0 with a 2.35 ERA striking out 49 in 50 and 2/3 innings. All-American Zach Uzzel will fill multiple roles as closer and spot starter as needed having already racked up 2 wins in the Fall and a no-hitter.

The offense will be led by Devin Levin (.394 AVG), Kiel Pitzer (.441 AVG), Justin Brands (.463 AVG), a new tandem from powerhouse St. Ignatius, Kevin Mingus and James Zajaczkowski, as well as speedy Freshman Cody Kutler. The team is already off to a hot start hitting .332 with a .448 OBP and 20 stolen bases in the Fall after posting a .345/.443/.447 slash line last year with a strong core of players returning from the undefeated conference team.
