2024 Spring Season Outlook:

The Huskies come into 2024 with a familiar list of players, but hold a different identity than in years past. Their new motto of “All In” is a steady reminder of what the group strives for in the aspect of a team environment. Playing your role to the best of your ability and going all in on whatever that role may be. And it seems to be working up to this point. After a dreadful 4-16 finish to the spring season in 2023, Bloomsburg had a resilient bounce back this past fall, playing to a record of 7-2. The team simply just played a great brand of baseball, scoring a plentiful amount of runs, tossing the ball significantly well, and making the necessary plays in the field. They return with a solid nucleus of players, headlined by seniors Lucas Citrino, Ryan Michalski and Danny Spearing. Spearing continued where he left from his junior season, hitting to a .312 average and leading the team in RBIs. Michalski pitched to a 2.19 ERA in 4 starts, tossing just over 22 innings, while Citrino transitioned from the middle infield over to the hot corner and fielded the position very well. The Huskies’ junior class is filled with key players that are ready to blossom. Outfielders Jayden Morene and Patrick Murphy continue to be mainstays in the lineup and in the field, roaming center and right field respectively. Dylan Dietz moved into the starting rotation and gave the club some quality innings, proving to be another reliable arm on the staff. Connor Fitzgerald and Gavin Garlinger will occupy spots in the middle of the order, both alternating between first base and the designated hitter position. The team was able to add sophomore Jackson Dacier back into the fray after missing the entirety of the previous year, which really sparked a plug as he took over the everyday job at shortstop. Dacier is also one of the couple reliant arms coming out of the Bloomsburg bullpen, along with sophomore Brandon Wieand, and the aforementioned Murphy. Like with every strong team, depth is a must and the Huskies have plenty of it. Senior Owen Thygeson and sophomore Owen Schmalldinst are solid

infield pieces that have already played a role in the team's success thus far. New freshmen were brought onto the squad as well. Outfielder Carlos Delarosa and reliever Owen Hynes have been welcome additions. The team's surprise of the fall has been none other than freshman pitcher Trey Sterling. Sterling quickly burst onto the scene and claimed his spot as the team's number one starter in the rotation. He tossed 16 innings allowing only two runs, giving him an ERA of a whopping 0.88. Getting healthy was definitely on the holiday wishlist of the Huskies, hoping to soon welcome back 5th year infielder Justin Swinko, who missed most of last season, as well as this year while nursing various injuries. They were however able to activate sophomore Alek Harkins back from an extended IL stint after a lengthy elbow injury in early 2023. Harkins returned playing the infield, but will look to get back out on the mound to give the squad some much needed length down the stretch. The Huskies ended 2023 on a high note, but are not at all satisfied and look to be even better in 2024. They'll be taxed with battling the good teams in their conference of the Chesapeake-West, but are confident that the group they've put together can compete and ultimately get Husky Nation back to the postseason for the first time in multiple years. Keep an eye on the boys of BU.

On the right day when things are clicking, our lineup can give teams a problem 1 through 9. We've improved our defense, especially in the premier spots on the diamond, and our starting rotation is the best we've had in years. After the fall we had, we'd like to think we're starting to turn some heads. We just have to do the little things right to keep the momentum going in the right direction. Swiping bags, executing with RISP, making the routine play, etc. In our program, we refer to it as our "Good-2-Great" journey. The past few seasons have been quite disappointing for us and I think pretty much everyone would agree with that. We've had real talent on those teams, but continuously we've shot ourselves in the foot by the way we've played collectively. I think we're really putting that chapter of Bloomsburg baseball behind us. Ultimately right now, our goal is to make the regional tournament this year. If you can get in there, you automatically give yourself a shot. If you're playing good ball and get hot in the playoffs, you can ride that wave of success and let it take you as far as it can go. We can't wait to get things started in February."
